LinkedIn goes mobile

Beta access via your phone's browser

LinkedIn, the world's largest professional network, has announced that its 19 million members can now access a LinkedIn web application via the internet browsers on web-enabled wireless phones.

Making LinkedIn available on mobile devices responds to both these business realities and will be great for our users."
