Harmon Kardon DMC 1000 media centre launches

On sale in the UK now

Harman Kardon has announced the UK availability of its digital media centre.

The Harman Kardon DMC 1000 is described as a "sleek, single box which offers people the chance to relax this winter with all their favourite music and DVDs all on the one device."

With a 250GB internal hard-drive, content can be copied from the hard-drive to an iPod, memory card, USB or CD-R/RW for use when on the go.

It offers CD ripping abilities, and optional iPod connectivity via Harman Kardon's The Bridge iPod docking station - sold separately.

The media centre can also be used as a DVD player. It supports all video formats and can up-scale standard-definition DVDs.

Said to be easy to use, the centre offers a simple menu screen that can be navigated using a remote control or the touch-sensitive front-panel.

The Harman Kardon DMC 1000 has a black finish and is available now at major retailers nationwide priced at a steep £1,800.
