## Sony lists PSP games line-up

### E3 software announcements for the PlayStation Portable platform

As well as announcing the October launch of the new PSP Go, Sony has revealed the forthcoming games line-up for the PlayStation portable platform at E3.

In addition, the company announced plans for new colours for the PSP-3000, due to be available in vibrant blue, mystic silver, pearl white, radiant red and lilac purple.

See below for a list of titles, in Sony's words, of what PSP gamers can look forward too soon.

#### Gran Turismo PSP

Not content with smashing records and raising standards in its previous PlayStation, PlayStation 2 and PS3 incarnations, legendary racer Gran Turismo makes its PSP debut with all the style, speed and supercars you could ask for - plus a whole lot more besides. Buckle up, take a deep breath and trounce the opposition on amazing tracks around the globe. You'll have your pick of over 800 jaw-droppingly realistic dream cars and 35 tracks, all lovingly recreated to rev, roll and roar just as they would in real life. Perfect physics and intelligent rivals make for an ultra-realistic driving experience - and one you can enjoy any time, anywhere on your own or head-to-head against friends.

#### SOCOM: Fireteam Bravo 3
