Panasonic launch the G51M

Panasonic has introduced the G51M mobile phone to the UK market. The small entry level phone features tri-band connectivity, 4,096 colour display, two built in games and polyphonic ring tones. The G51M comes in a brushed silver finish and supports Enhanced Messaging Service (EMS), downloadable wallpapers and ring tones, WAP browsing and a desktop handsfree facility. Panasonic is also pushing the size and weight being 74grams and has dimensions of 80x43x19mm. Panasonic purports to offering 2.5 to 6 hours talk time and up to 200 hours standby time. The 20 built-in melodies featured make the most of the polyphonic ring tones and for users that want to personalise the G51M additional wallpapers and ring tones are available to download from Summary Panasonic G51M
